## Proven Record

- **90.6% Assembly Victory (April 2026).** Won the Republican assembly for SD25 with a decisive 90.6% of the delegate vote.
- **Three U.S. Supreme Court Amicus Victories.** Co-authored three amicus briefs in landmark cases protecting children, parental rights, and constitutional speech — including the Skrametti decision. All three resulted in wins.
- **First Amendment Lawsuit.** Sued the Colorado state legislature, represented by the Institute for Free Speech, after being silenced during public testimony. Took on compelled speech and government censorship.
